

Information for First Term Master Students of the Hanse Law School – Winter Term 2022/23

Dear students,

Welcome to the master program “Transnational law” of the Hanse Law School. The Hanse Law School is a cooperation program between the University of Oldenburg and the University of Bremen. That means that you will have to take seminars both, at the University of Oldenburg and the University of Bremen while you are only enrolled at the University of Bremen. However, you can travel free of charge with the local and regional public transportation between the University of Bremen and the University of Oldenburg using the student's regional transportation ticket (“Semesterticket”), which you received along with you enrolment materials from the University of Bremen.

While the teaching is divided between the universities, all administrative matters (enrolment, exam administration, coordination, ...) are organized by the University of Bremen. It is, therefore, of great importance that you read your emails sent to you university email account of the University of Bremen on a regular basis. As we do not receive you personally contact details for data protection reasons and we do not have access to your personal email address, we can only reach all students enrolled in one semester using the “InfoMail-Tool” of the University of Bremen. Also emails from the student and exam administration will be automatically sent to your university email account.

Before or during the first week of studies, it is important that you register yourself for the courses you are going to participate in via the campus management system Stud.IP. That applies both, for the mandatory and elective classes. The list of mandatory and elective courses offered by the University of Oldenburg or the University of Bremen are listed below. Unfortunately, you must register for each seminar in the Stud.IP-system of the university where the seminar is offered. If a class is offered by the University of Bremen, please login via <https://elearning.uni-bremen.de/> using the username and password, which have been provided to you during the enrolment process. That are the same user data, which you are also using to login to your email account, the exam management system “PABO” and all other IT-services offered by the University of Bremen. If a seminar is offered by the University of Oldenburg, you can also login with the same user name and password.
